DAY 1: MY PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Psalm 42:1 NLT

As the deer longs for streams of water, so I long for you, O God...

DAY 2: GOD'S GUIDANCE FOR THE REST OF THE YEAR

Psalm 16:7-8 NIV

I will praise the Lord, who counsels me; even at night, my heart instructs me. 8 I keep my eyes always on the Lord. With him at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

DAY 3: OUR NEXT STEPS

Psalm 25:4-5 NLT

Show me the right path, O Lord; point out the road for me to follow.5 Lead me by your truth and teach me, for you are the God who saves me. All-day long I put my hope in you.

DAY 4: OUR JOBS Jeremiah 31:16 NLT

But now this is what the Lord says: "Do not weep any longer, for I will reward you," says the Lord. "Your children will come back to you from the distant land of the enemy.

DAY 5: OUR FINANCES

Philippians 4:19 NIV

And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

DAY 6: OUR HEALTH (BODY, SOUL, AND SPIRIT)

Isaiah 53: 4-5 NIV

Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds, we are healed.

DAY 7: OUR FAMILY 2 Corinthians 1:4 NLT

He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us.

DAY 9: FOR PEOPLE TO FIND FREEDOM

John 8:36 NIV

So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

James 5:16 NLT

Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.

DAY 10: FOR PEOPLE TO DISCOVER THEIR PURPOSE

Ephesians 2:10 NIV

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

John 15:16 NIV

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you...

DAY 11: FOR OUR CHURCH TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Matthew 5:14-16 NIV

"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. 2 Chronicles 7:14 NIV

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

DAY 16: PEACE AND UNITY

Jeremiah 29:7 NKJV

7 And seek the peace of the city whither I have cause you, to be carried away captives, and pray unto the Lord for it: for in the peace thereof shall ye have peace.

DAY 17: PRESIDENT, GOVERNORS, AND LEADERS

1 Timothy 2:1-3 NIV

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession, and thanksgiving be made for all people 2 for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. 3 This is good and pleases God our Savior.

DAY 18: STUDENTS, TEACHERS, AND ALL EDUCATION ADMINISTRATORS Matthew 5:16 NIV

In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

DAY 19: All THE WORKERS IN SERVICE OF OUR COMMUNITY

(Nurses, Doctors, Police Officers, Fire Fighters, etc)

Galatians 6:9 NLT

So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessings if we don't give up.

DAY 20: COMPLETE PROTECTION FROM GOD

Psalm 46:1 NIV

God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

DAY 21: SUPERNATURAL REVIVAL

Acts 2:1-2 NIV
