2. Turn away from sin and confess your sins to God



Elohim: God the Creator

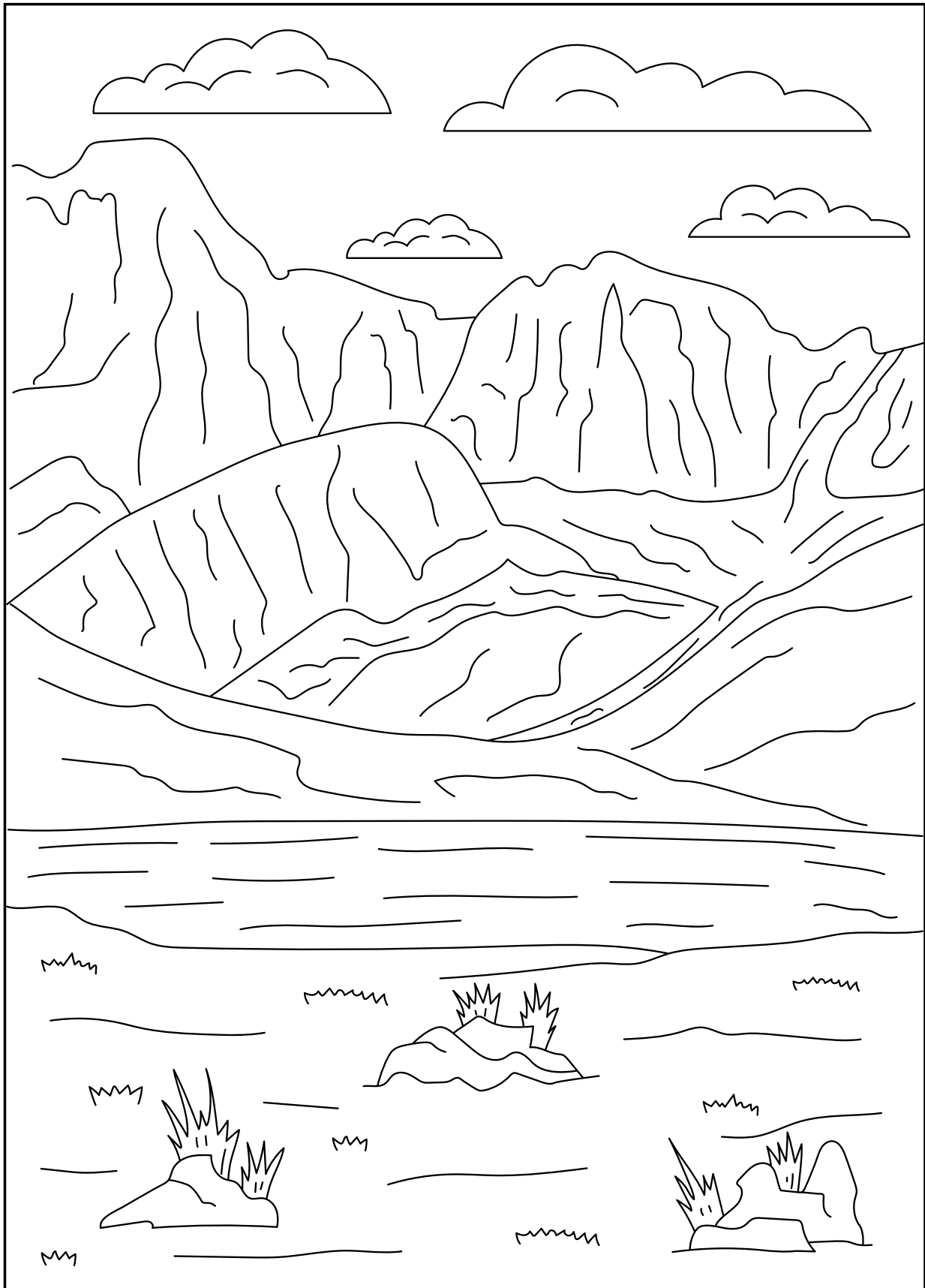
"In the beginning, God created the heavens and

“So she (Hagar) called the name of the Lord who spoke to her, “You are a God of seeing,” for she said, “Truly here I have seen him who looks after me.”

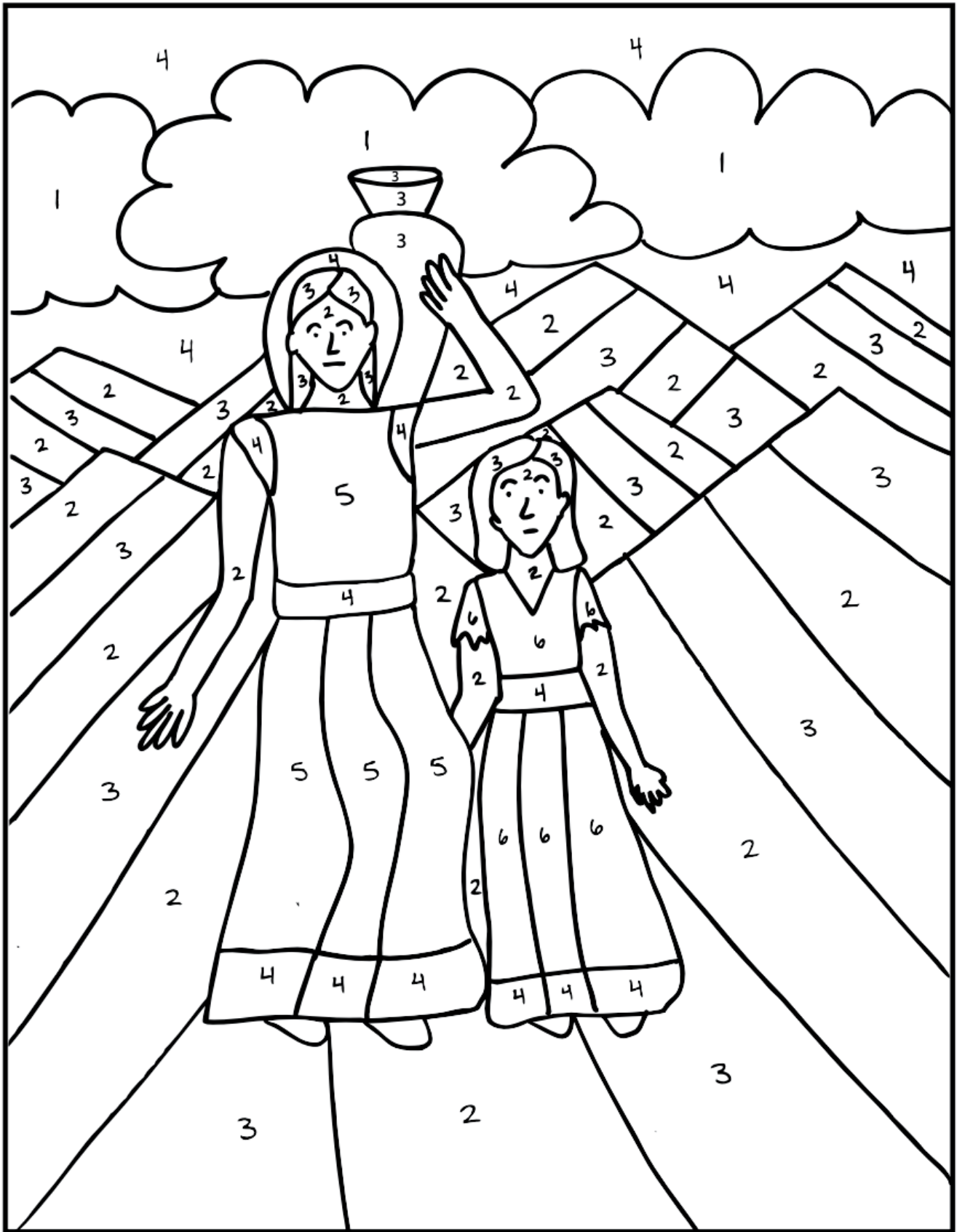
Genesis 16:13

El Olam: Everlasting God

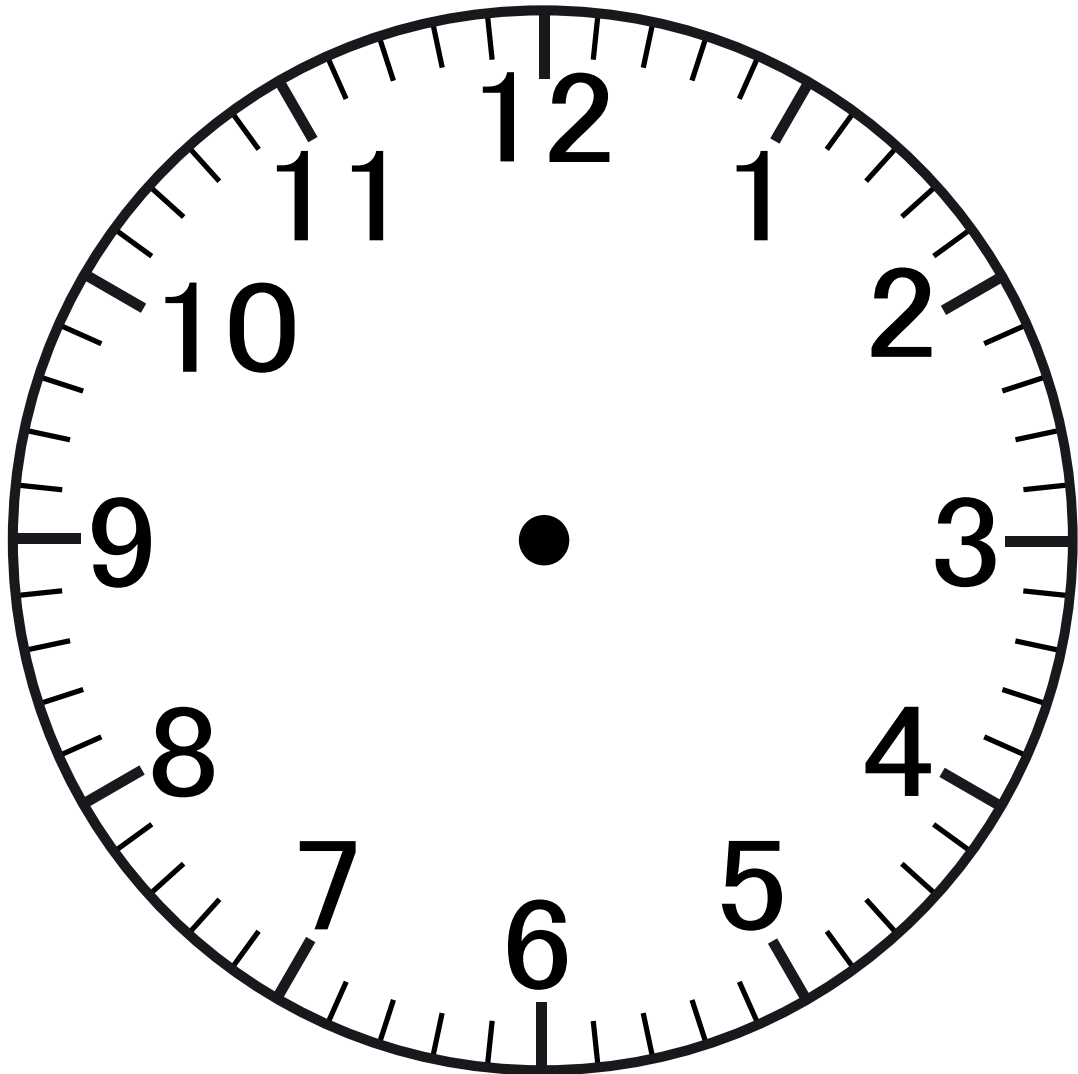
“Abraham planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba and called there on the name of the Lord, the Everlasting God.”

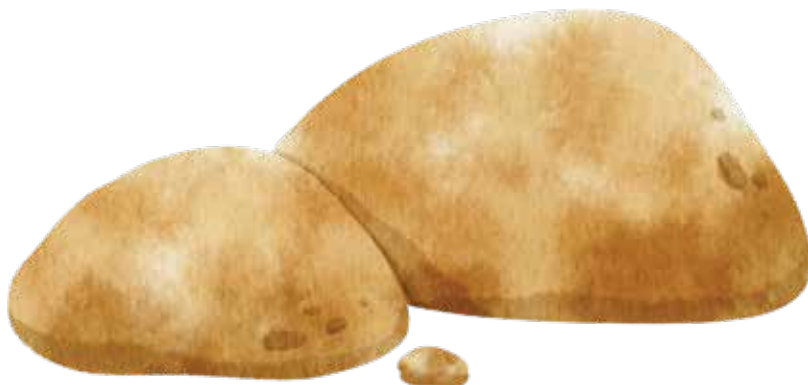

The One and Only


Jehovah or Yaweh: I Am

Jehovah Jireh: God my Provider

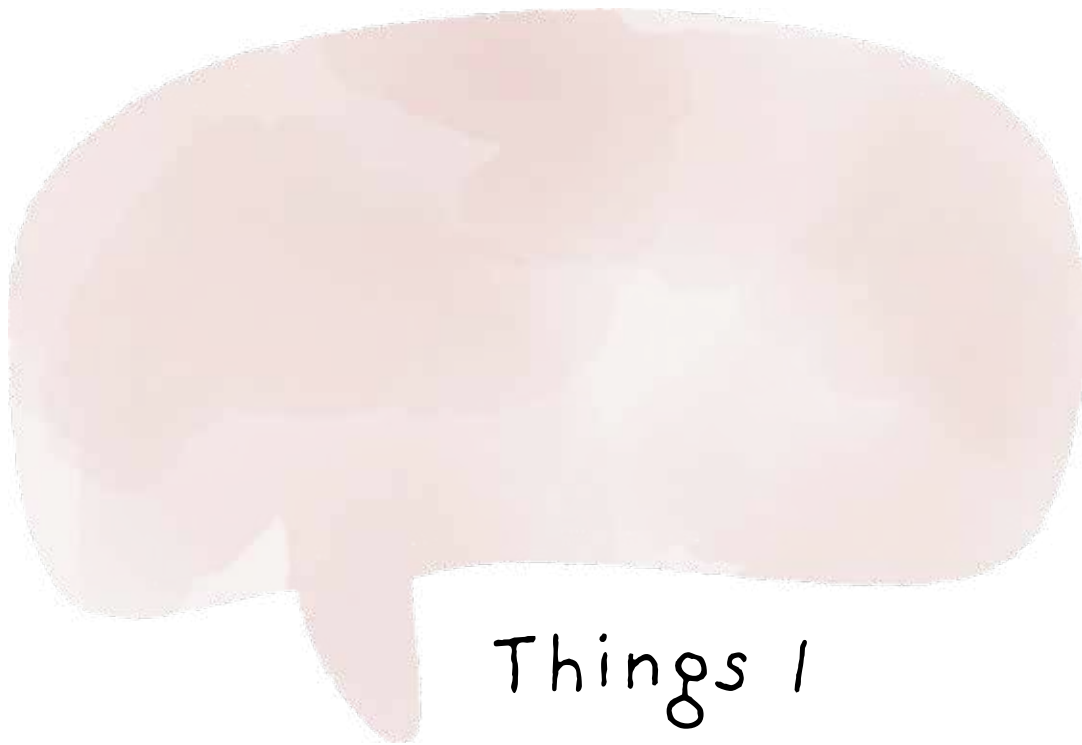
“And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.”

Phillipians 4:19

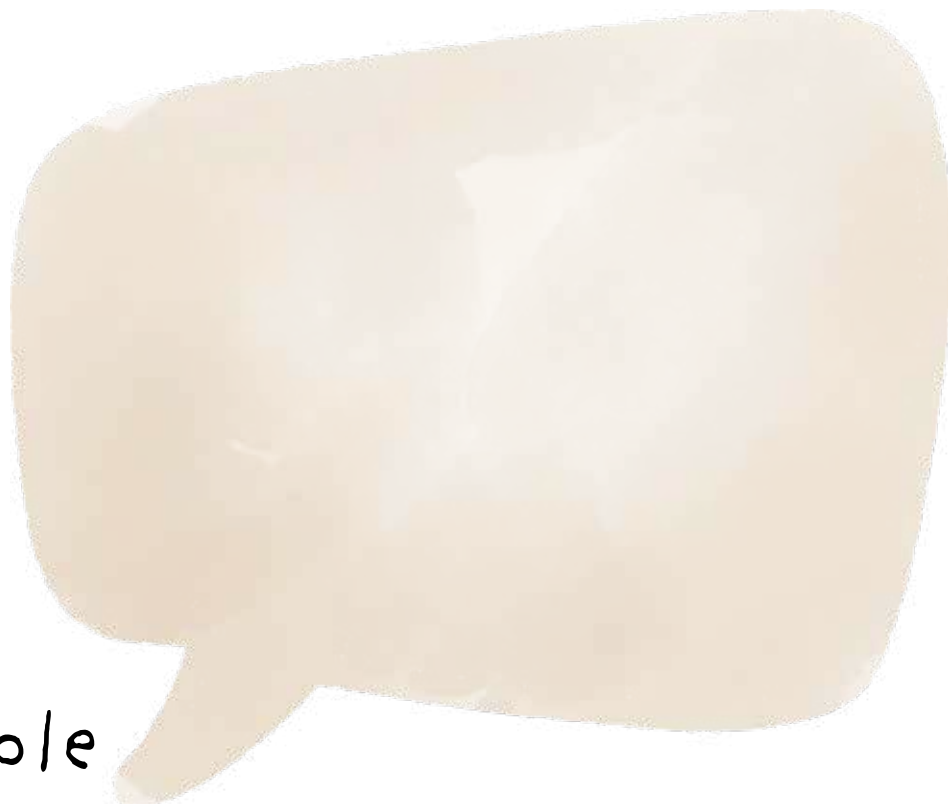

My Heart, His Son

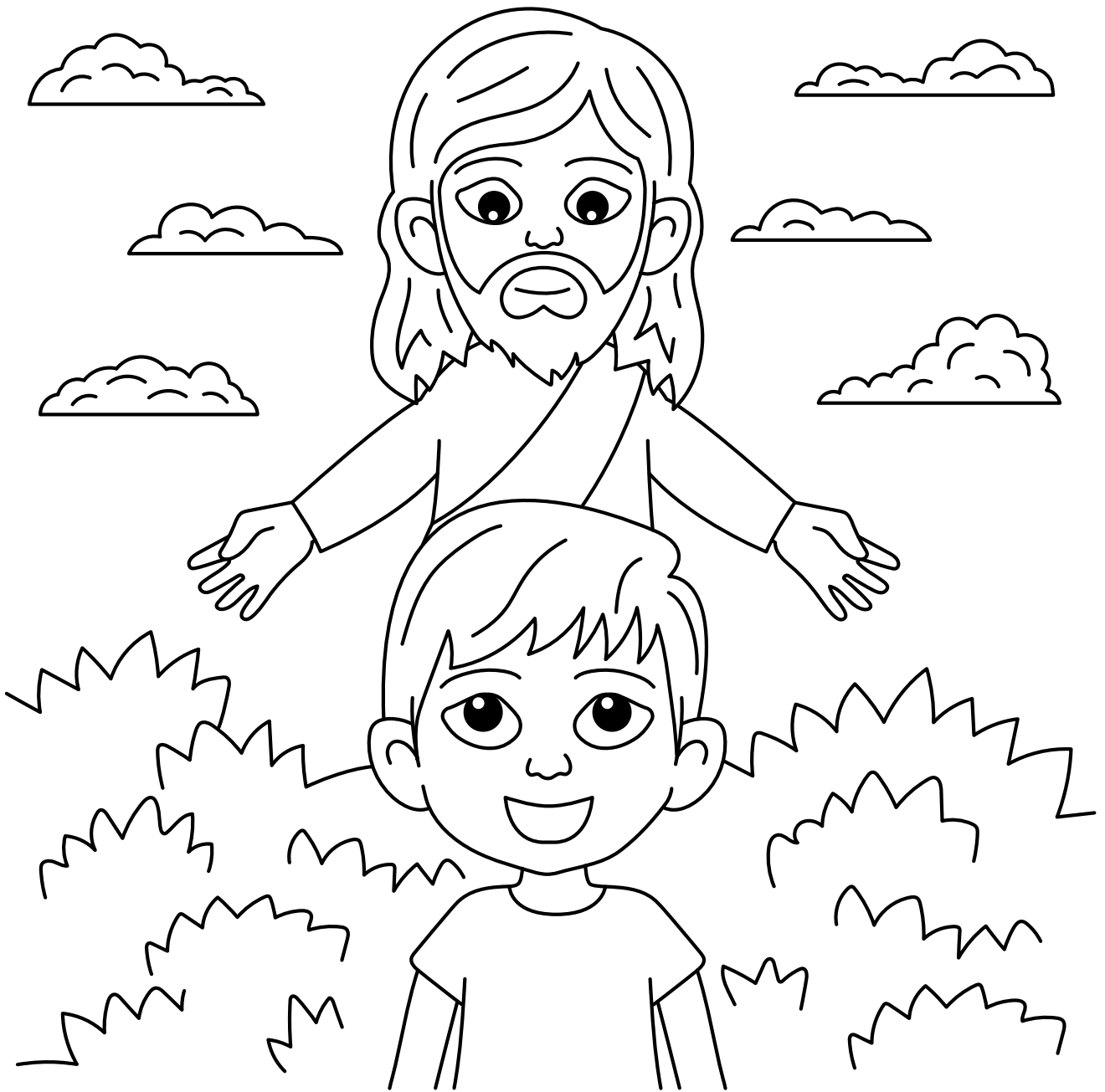
Jehovah Shaphat: The Lord

Isaiah 26:3

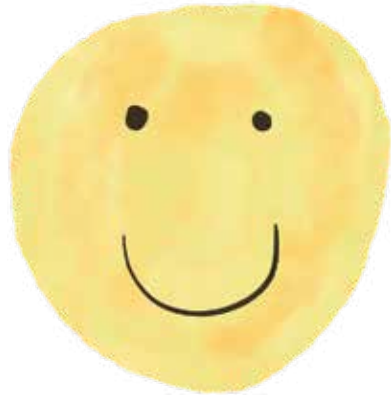

Better Than a Band-Aid


Jehovah Rapha: God My Healer

Day 19

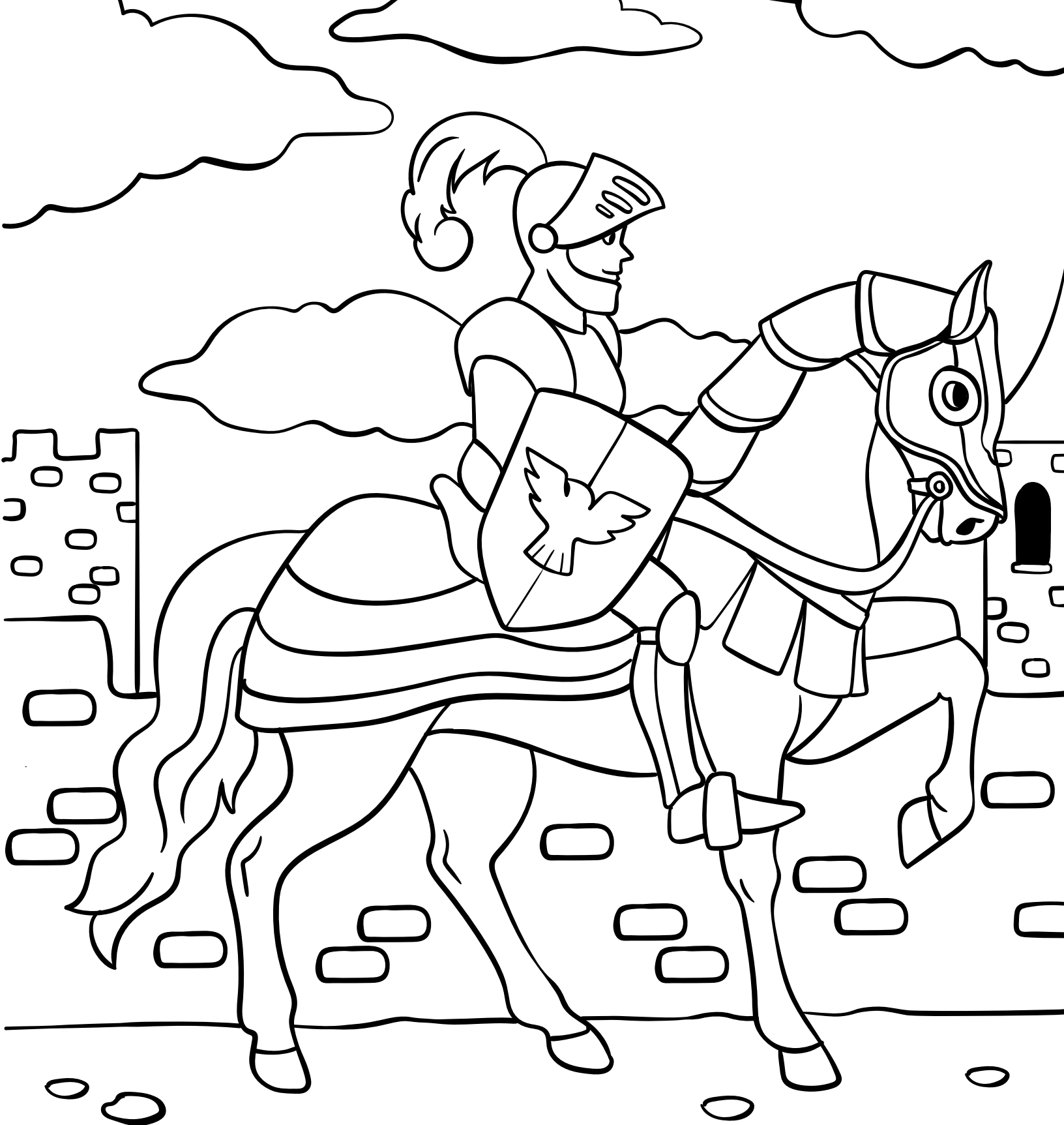
The Battle is the Lord's

The Lord our Righteousness


“A King shall reign and prosper, and execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.”

Try as hard as you want, but mistakes happen.
